Frustyle Trend in Style, 8 mth Pied, good overall balanced dog, strong typical masculine head with broad, deep, well padded muzzle and broad lower jaw, good dentition, plenty of fill under dark expressive eyes with correct surrounding pigmentation, good ear size and shape although a little lazy in use. Well muscled thick neck, correct shoulder placement, straight front with excellent bone, sound pasterns, tight feet. Deep chest, well sprung ribs, short compact well muscled loin, well rounded rear quarters with adequate angulation. Moved well when settled and should improve with age and training 2 Smith's Yakee On the Wild Side at Bouffon, 7 mth Pied, Larger though compact male with typical masculine head, broad square deep muzzle and lower jaw, would like a little more fill under his dark eyes, good rise of skull to upright ear carriage of good size and shape, Thick neck to well set shoulders, correct front assembly sound pasterns, neat feet, well sprung ribs to short loin, top line okay. Muscled rear quarters, would like a little more angulation. Presented in good condition and nicely handled.3 Mabey's Rowendale Marc Jacobs Oakprides, 7 mth Fawn of good size with plenty of substance, strong masculine head, good fill under nice dark eyes, well placed ears carried upright. Short neck, straight front, sound pasterns, neat feet. Well sprung ribs, short loin, with gentle roach over muscular rear quarters, and correct rear angulation. Front movement a little tight.PD 7(3)1 Critchley's Jolilaid Par Excellence, 10mth Brindle of good size and substance, nice overall balance, larger masculine head, broad square deep muzzle with broad under jaw, plenty of fill under well shaped dark expressive eyes, correct rise of skull to medium sized ears carried upright. Strong neck to well set shoulders and correct front assembly with sound pasterns and tight feet .compact body gentle roach over muscular well rounded rear quarters would prefer a little more angulation, moved okay but looked a little over weight today.2 Bootle's Tommyville Twill Will, 8mth Brindle larger than 1st, strong masculine head, well padded muzzle, well shaped dark eyes, Ears of good size carried upright and used well to show alert expression, strong thick neck, straight front, deep chest, sound pasterns and neat feet. Good tuck up to adequate rear quarters, moved okay. 3 Mabey's Rowendale Marc Jacobs Oakprides. JD 8(5)1 & RBD. Toes's Alsuma Pale Ryder for Zeppelin, Pied of medium size well balanced and presented a nice outline, masculine head, broad square muzzle and lower jaw, plenty of fill under soft expressive dark eyes of good shape and placement. Correct rise of skull to upright ears used well giving alert expression, thick neck to front assembly, good bone, upright pasterns and neat feet. Compact body with well sprung ribs, muscled loin and correct top line and tail set. Muscular rear quarters with good second thigh Moved well... 2 Williams' Rustar Aristocrat at Willrait, Larger Brindle a little higher on the leg than 1st Softer masculine head, broad muzzle and lower jaw, well filled under the dark expressive eyes, ears carried upright of good size and shape used well to give alert expression. Arched neck, sound front assembly short compact body with well rounded ribs. Muscular rear quarters, moved okay.3 Piper's Heidsieck Hennessey Venom, Medium sized Brindle with good overall balance, square deep well padded muzzle, plenty of fill under dark eyes, ears upright and alert, thick neck, straight front, sound pasterns and tight feet. A compact body with well sprung ribs, muscled loin and rear quarters, angulation okay, moved well.2 Waltham's Grandesigns Checkmate Von Dringshaw, Larger Brindle not quite the balanced outline of 1st, typical masculine head, dark well shaped eyes, ears carried upright and used well giving alert expression, thick arched neck and straight front, neat feet. Well sprung ribs, good topline and tailset, rear quarters okay would prefer a little more rear angulation. 3 Wood's Emberez Diablo with Delightbull, Smaller Pied, overall balance okay, large masculine head with broad square muzzle. deep lower jaw, correct pigmentation around dark eyes, ears of good size and shape carried upright, short thick neck to front assembly, body okay, tail set high, good rear angulation, front movement let him down... MLD 3(1) 1 Tilley's Mossport Michelangelo, Larger Brindle with very good overall balance and outline. strong masculine head, broad deep well padded muzzle and strong lower jaw, dark eyes of good size and shape giving soft expression, correct rise of skull to ears carried upright and used well. Thick well muscled neck to well set shoulder and straight front, sound pasterns and tight feet, deep chest and well rounded ribs, good topline and tailset, well rounded muscular rear quarters showing adequate second thigh and sufficient rear angulation, moved freely and steadily around the ring. 2. Stansfield's Mayobie the Musician JW ShCM, Another larger Brindle male with good overall balance and outline, typical larger masculine head with well spaced dark expressive eyes, ears of good size and shape carried upright, thick neck to correct shoulder placement, straight front and tight feet with dark nails, not the topline of 1st well rounded muscular rear quarters, movement okay. Charles & Kelly's Ageancourt New Moon, Medium sized Brindle, nicely balanced male looking square in outline, broad deep masculine head with well padded muzzle and good fill under dark expressive eyes, a little lazy in ear carriage, muscled neck to well set shoulders and correct front assembly, compact body, short muscular loin, nice gentle roach with well rounded rear quarters, sufficient angulation and good second thigh, moved well. 2 Birks Harrowhill Sovereign Birique, Medium sized Brindle. balanced male who showed well in outline, blocky masculine head, with upright ears of good shape and size. Thick neck, broader in front assembly than 1st, sound pasterns and neat feet. Well sprung ribs, short loin with muscular rear quarters with good second thigh and correct tailset.3 Fraser Kaye & Bootle's Harrowhill Sweet William at Daitoff, Smaller compact Brindle with a broad deep masculine head, soft expressive dark eyes with good under fill, upright in ear carriage although a little lazy on the day, thick neck to good front assembly sound pasterns and tight feet. Muscular loin to balanced rear quarters, moved okay.

Pleasing clean blocky masculine head with well padded broad deep muzzle and lower jaw, good mouth, broad dark nostrils, well shaped dark eyes with correct outer pigmentation and plenty of under fill, deep stop with good rise of skull to upright ears, used well to give lovely alert expression. Strong thick neck, well set shoulders and excellent front assembly, with good bone sound pasterns & tight feet. Deep chest, well sprung ribs, strong muscular loin, topline with nice gentle roach to spot on tail set over well rounded muscular rear quarters with visible second thigh. Always ready to go he settled quickly on the move going very freely around the ring well presented and handled. A credit to his breeder and his owner.2 Kennedy's Tax Man Tommyville, Larger Brindle, not quite the balanced outline of 1st, sound masculine head with well padded broad, deep muzzle and square lower jaw. Plenty of under fill to soft dark expressive eyes, ears carried upright and alert, strong neck to okay shoulders, straight front with sound pasterns. A little long in body, rear quarters adequate, moved okay. VD (1) 1 Birks' Birique Prinzregent. 10yr old Fawn of medium size, presented in lovely condition. Good overall balance in outline, strong masculine head, square, broad muzzle and lower jaw, well shaped dark expressive eyes, good stop and rise of skull to upright ears used well to show alert response. Thick neck to well set shoulders, straight front and tight feet. Compact body with muscled loin correct topline and gentle roach over well rounded rear quarters with visible second thigh, moved well. Settled into a nice flowing movement for one so young. 2 Swateridge's Xentique Boutique 8mth old, compact Fawn a little bigger than 1st but well balanced giving nice square outline, larger feminine head with broad, deep well padded muzzle, good depth of lower jaw, dark eyes, ears carried upright and used well, thick neck to well set shoulders and correct front assembly, ribs well rounded and rear quarters developing clear musculation, good angulation, just preferred over all finish of 1st ,moved well. 3 Howarth's Gizyjo Miss Garbo, 7mth old Fawn, another lovely baby, very feminine, but not yet quite as balanced overall as 1st or 2nd ,soft expressive dark eyes, well padded, broad, deep muzzle, with well defined lower jaw. Thick neck to well set shoulders and straight front, neat feet. muscular compact body, well rounded rear quarters, correct tail set and good rear angulation. Moved well and well handled. Body a little longer than 1st, rear longer body style. 3 Brown's Eastonite it's All About Mimi at Kuredeux quarters well rounded and good angulation movement is a little looser in keeping with, Fawn a little larger and longer in body than 1st & 2nd, Larger Feminine head with dark expressive eyes, rim and nose pigmentation correct. Ear carriage upright and of good size and shape, thick neck, front assembly correct, sound pasterns and deep chest, topline with gentle roach, well rounded rear quarters. Movement could be a little tighter in front. Compact body with short loin and good tuck-up, nice gentle roach, well rounded muscular rear quarters. Quickly dropped into her stride, with free flowing movement around the ring .Well handled. 2 Conway's Anashell Bombproof, Brindle, this is another nicely balanced bitch, slightly different in type to 1st ,larger typical head with a soft feminine expression, would like the eyes a little darker, the muzzle is well padded broad and deep, broad nostrils, good stop and rise of clean broad skull, ear placement is upright and of good size and shape. Arched strong neck to compact body, straight front, sound pasterns and neat feet, deep chest good tuck up and well rounded rear quarters with second thigh defined. Moved well around the ring. 3 Keates' Nokomis Prairie Flower, Brindle, not quite the balance of 1st & 2nd typical feminine head, broad and deep well padded muzzle with broad lower jaw. Deep stop, well shaped, dark eyes giving soft expression, clean rise of skull ,well placed ears carried upright and used well. Strong elegant neck, sound bone and pasterns. Deep chest and good tuck up well rounded rear quarters and good angulation, moved smartly around the ring OB 3(1) 1 Birks' Birique Xcepshional, Compact Fawn, balanced feminine head, broad, deep, well padded muzzle, deep stop and good rise of skull, dark expressive eyes with very good rim pigmentation, ears carried upright and used well, strong thick neck to well set shoulders and correct front assembly, broad deep chest well sprung ribs, correct topline, short loin, muscled, rounded rear quarters, evident second thigh. Moved okay 2 Bootle & Harrison's Too Too Much at Foleyfarm JW. Brindle, typical broad deep blocky head with larger dark eyes giving a soft feminine expression, thick neck, well set shoulders, sound straight front, neat feet. Unfortunately on the day her ear carriage showed a lack of interest in the proceedings and remained unexcited throughout her time in the ring so the overall expression and impression was spoiled. VB 5(2) 1 & BVIS Harrison's Tommyville Thora Thorndyke, 11.3/4 yrs old, fawn, still looking and moving well, medium sized with very good overall balance, clean feminine head still showing good pigmentation, square deep padded muzzle and lower jaw, soft dark expressive eyes with good under fill and deep stop, skull rising to well placed ears carried upright, clean front assembly straight and well muscled with sound pasterns and tight feet, her compact body and rounded rear quarters still helping her to move well around the ring. 2 Russell's Acirema Love in A Mist. 12.1/2vrs old Brindle, feminine head with dark and soft expressive eyes, facial pigmentation is still good, holding back the grey, ears remain upright and carried well, strong neck, clean straight front and neat feet, with deep chest and compact body, rear movement not that of 1st. 3 North & Holland's Tommyville Tidgy Pud, 10 yr old larger Brindle, not quite the compact outline of 1st & 2nd larger balanced feminine head with broad muzzle and lower jaw, eyes dark with good fill underneath, skull clean, deep stop, medium sized ears carried upright and gave occasional alert expressive response. Thick neck, okay shoulder placement and straight clean front. A little long in body, rear movement let her down. Sp.O Pied B 3(1), 1 Swateridge's Skybull Marie Antoinette, larger bitch with good overall balance and outline, feminine head with broad deep muzzle and square lower jaw, very good facial pigmentation softening the look, large dark expressive eyes, ear carriage was a little lazy today, strong muscular neck, well set shoulders, straight sound front with good bone, well sprung ribs to compact body and gentle rise over the loin to well rounded rear quarters and high tail set. Movement okay .2nd Gill's D Jessica's Daisy at C Sp.O Br.B 2(1) 1 Wood's Stanley Girl Mega at Delightbull, Smaller brindle, typical feminine head still a little immature and lacks some balance, large dark eyes with soft expression deep stop, ear carriage upright and used well when alert. Shoulder placement okay, straight front with sound pasterns, compact body with correct topline and gentle roach over well rounded rear quarters, movement okay. Sp.O Fawn B 3(1) 1 & BPB, S Let It Be.2 Chambers' Glenlee Indian Spirit at Luvum. Smaller bitch, looks balanced in outline, typical feminine head with well padded muzzle, deep stop and good rise of skull, dark expressive eyes, eye rims and nose with deep pigmentation. Well placed ears of good size and shape carried erect, thick neck ,compact body, correct topline with gentle rise of the short muscled loin and well rounded rear quarters, would prefer a little more rear angulation, moved okay and was well handled.





BAGS OF FRENCH BULLDOGS

Fans of the breed are doubtless aware of the multitude of bags (and other accessories) available to Frenchie lovers today. Ben de Lisi, Ted Baker, Kenneth Cole, Thomas Sabo and others keep us well supplied with tempting goodies. Well, 'twas ever thus! We hope you enjoy looking at some of the bags enjoyed by Frenchie ladies.

On the right is a leather bag, of high quality from the 1920s. The clasp is a beautifully carved wooden Frenchie head, with fine glass eyes and the plaited leather collar dropping down to a ring, probably for holding gloves. There are two inside pockets; one a purse fitted with a clasp, the other an elasticated top pouch. There is a leather strap along the back of the bag so that it can be worn, as was fashionable at one time, on the sleeve. It measures 8.5" x 6"

The bag alongside it is a child's purse bag, measuring 9" x 6", from the 40s. Made in soft leather with padded suede lining one wonders how it has survived so long! As with the two other children's items which follow, they must have been loved and played with by children and survived the parents' urge to dispose of them when outgrown!





The pictures above shows another superb quality ladies clutch bag, this one in finely hand tooled leather and measuring 12.5" x 6.5". In fine condition, it is, under the closure flap, finely engraved with the name 'Mary'. This is another example from the 1920s – how lucky were the Frenchie loving ladies of that period!









The pictures above show two children's muffs, dating from the early 1900s (1910 approx.) and both incorporating a zip purse. These were made in USA and have great personality and detail. I am sure they were – and are – much loved.





This picture shows another 'oldie' – this exquisite needlepoint evening bag is most likely pre 1920. Measuring 6" x 7.5" it has a delightful Frenchie head embossed at the top of the metal frame just under the clasp.

More recently, it was essential for Frenchie lovers to visit the trade stand of Wallace Leather at Crufts. From the late 70s to 2009 this small stand had wonderful examples of hand made leather bags painted of every breed of dog and cat. The late Alan Wallace made the bags, all sizes from purses to large travel bags, and his wife, Josephine, did the paintings. She usually painted from a photograph of the clients own dog and one had to wait a few months for the bag to arrive—but they were always well worth the wait! The handbag / shoulder bag illustrated is 11.5" x 14.5" a 5.5".

Available at present, with the many other designer bags, are those from Fuzzy Nation. Looking like a cuddly toy they have leather shoulder straps and a zip to the top. In various sizes – the box which contains the one shown measurs 13" x 10" x 4.5" – and various styles, they are all rather glamorous. There is a small, 6" long fine satin-brocade evening purse, which also sports a zip top and tiny leather strap, which can undo to become a leash! Sadly this little model has a small Pug-like tail, but innovative Frenchie ladies have docked the tail, sewn up the seam – and lo! a show quality Frenchie!

Welfare Annual report 2012


Once again throughout 2012 we have seen further dramatic increases in the numbers of Frenchie puppies being registered with the kennel club. The total for the year being over 4648, a rise of 68% over 2011 the like of which has never even been seen in other numerically larger breeds than ours . Also the increase in the importation of Frenchies mainly from eastern European countries has gained more momentum this year. The effect of this increase has been seen in the mass increase in puppy sales on Internet sites from puppy farmers and unscrupulous breeders. The newest, most worrying trend however is the breeding of 'Blue Frenchies' in the UK. This is increasing, The kennel club whilst registering these Blues as 'Colour not recognised by the KC' is still falling a long way short of what is needed. We must try to keep the pressure on them to get their act together and think of the dogs and not their cash surplus.

Most importantly in all of this, from the Trust point of view, is yet again an increase in Frenchies coming into the Welfare. In 2012 we were involved with the re-homing of 45 + dogs and 10+ dogs needing other forms of help. Once again the problems we have encountered among the re-homed dogs this year have seen a marked increase in temperament problems. One dog was put to sleep after an unprovoked attack on a young girl, and, at least two others euthanised after unprovoked attacks on people. This is not normal Frenchie temperament. Most problems are still being created through the ignorance of original owners regarding socialisation etc. Some are now possibly going back to poor or suspect breeding practices etc. We have also seen a marked increase in medical problems, allergy/food intolerance problems. Other problems have come from lack of basic care (cleaning ears etc.) thankfully a little patience; TLC and knowledgeable Trust Vets have put some of these things right. The dogs this year have aged from 8 months old to a pair of 7yr olds, again most dogs being around the 14 months -3 year old mark. I see this trend continuing in 2013.

Again we have had a larger influx of dogs around November to January. This year for example we had 7 dogs in one week. The breed's popularity with celebrities continues and is not helping the problem of 'flavour of the month' owners etc. especially when celebrities parade their Frenchie on TV programs. We need to look at ways to try to educate the public about the benefits and problems arising from ownership of our breed. Later in the year we are hoping to hold a symposium on how we can do this, hoping to bring together interested and influential parties.

Finally, I would like to thank those who have helped the Trust over the last year with the business side, and the sterling work of those who raise funds for the Trust. We hope others will join us in trying to place dogs in need in touch with those who can give them the safe, healthy, loving environment they all deserve.
